



AC Ellis Photography Session Options:

Here are some definitions to help with understanding the different types of sessions. Collections are available- please inquire.

Standard Family Session:

My passion is to create images that, when viewed, evoke emotion. It is important to record the interaction and relationships between family members. It is those image that will become cherished later on. Posed images sitting in front of a backdrop do not do this. These sessions last up to 2 hours and are on location with unlimited options for locations, clothes and unposed possibilities. Families are not allowed in the studio.

Studio Session:

Studio sessions are for simply creating quality modern portraits that capture the expressions of the subject. These are great in between the standard family sessions, for yearbook images, first day of school, etc. These sessions only allow for one outfit, background and lighting set-up and up to 5 subjects for a total of 20 minutes.

Select Session:

A limited time only session with a specific theme, motif or props. May be on-location, in-studio or any variety of things.

Extended Family Session:

To get all the brothers, sisters, their spouses, children, etc. in one image. Again this is not done in the studio on a backdrop. These are done on-location and are treated like a custom designed portrait session. We will work together to find the right location and plan attire for the subjects. During these sessions smaller family groupings and individual portraits of everyone are also taken. These sessions are up to 1.5 hours and may be at multiple locations.

Family Essay:

To show all that the family does together, the simple things like dinner and bath time. Did you ever want to tell the story of your day to day? We do. Essays are commissioned for up to a day and a half. Cory Ann will spend time with the family recording all of the happenings as an outsider. These images are presented in a finished book.

Portrait Essay:

For that essay of grandpa or dad or mom who has a wonderful job, craft, giving heart, etc, or maybe a lost trade that you wish you had a visual record off to tell to your children and be passed down. Like the family essay, Cory Ann will spend up to a day and a half with the subject. These images are presented in a finished book.

Graduate Session:

To record what you look like, what you were active in, your style, and your personality. It is fun upon the anticipation of high school graduation to mark the change about to occur in your life. These sessions last up to 2 hours and there are no limits to the locations or outfits. Time in the studio is allowed, but is limited. We will work together to design the session that best fits you.

Engagement or Couples Session:

A fun session with the couple. It's important to record relationships and fun to display the images. Many people only do these sessions for their engagement, but others come back year after year. It's fun to see the relationship change and grow. Up to 1.5 hours.

Couture Session:

Typically for the bride and groom after the wedding, maybe the next day or the next week. Custom designed for each couple. These sessions are great to get a bit more time together looking your best and still on a high from the wedding. You pay for the dress and you should get great use out of it. Up to 2 hours

Intimate Session:

Intimate because you are bearing yourself to the camera. These sessions are wonderful gifts, but they are not limited to women. Men are welcome to also do these sessions, as well as couples. The images created are great to display in the bedroom and detailed body landscapes can add a touch of art to any room in your home.

Corporate Headshots:

For the professional who would like headshots for their business cards, website, and other marketing materials. You can choose to do these in studio or on-location.

Commercial Photography:

For businesses for use to promote their business.
